

THE BIBLE TREE

Psalms 1:3

The Bible contains 3,566,480 letters, 810,697 words, 31,175 verses, 1,189 chapters, and 66 books. The shortest and middle chapter is the 117 th Psalm. The middle verse contains 50 letters. The longest name is the eighth chapter of Isaiah. The word "and" occurs 46,672 times throughout the entire Bible, while the word Lord appears 1,855 times. The 37th chapter of Isaiah and the 19th chapter of the Second book of Kings are alike. The longest the Bible is the 9th verse of the 8th chapter of Esther, and the shortest verse is the 35th verse of the 11th chapter of John. With the exception of the letter "J" the Alphabet is found in Ezra 7:21. The name of God is not mentioned in the Book of Esther. The model prayer is the 17th chapter of John. The Lord wants each church member to be an attender, not an absentee; a pillar, not a sleeper; a wing, not a weight; a goer, not a gabber; a booster, not a knocker; a true soldier, not a slacker. The Bible contains history, romance, justice, salvation, holiness, knowledge, wisdom and love. This is the tree of life. Hide yourself in its branches and bring forth fruit. Via
